Juvenile Truancy → ↑ Graduation Rate

- **Change current truancy and suspension policies**
 - In-school suspension vs. current suspension policies
- **Increase family involvement**
 - ↑ schools + parents communication; monitor attendance + performance
 - Mandate parent & child classes for children who break law
- **Expand Before and After school programs:**
 - Recreation centers for after school programs
- **Select classes based on strengths and abilities**
 - Extracurricular activities
 - In school classes such as carving, mechanics to build skills that could eventually be profitable
- **Community case management for at risk students**

Graduation Rate Strategies

- Focus groups to identify obstacles
 - Parent focus groups
 - At risk student focus groups
- Vocational and Technical schools
 - Career guidance
 - Enhance and market at local community colleges
- Improve relationships between school, teachers and parents
 - Sensitivity to cultural and family values
 - Involve/engage/educate parents on school activities/system
 - Schools monitor performance and attendance of at risk students, provide feedback to their parents

Workforce Readiness

- Vocational and Technical schools
 - Career guidance: that this is an option
 - Enhance and market at local community colleges
 - Ensure accessibility and affordability
- Guidance
 - Early career guidance at 5th grade
 - ↑ awareness of available financial assistance
 - Career centers to assist teenagers with job applications, resume writing
- Build Students' Skills
 - Volunteer opportunities
 - Job shadowing programs
 - Summer jobs

Promotion of Life Skills & Healthy Lifestyle

- Promote family support programs
- Parent education/engagement
 - To encourage healthy behaviors in children
- Promote healthy behavior
 - Through educating parents and enhancing collaboration with different agencies
- Health education
 - Grade level appropriate
- Life skill programs
 - Budgeting classes
- High school related activities
 - Onsite child care; teach harm reduction techniques;
